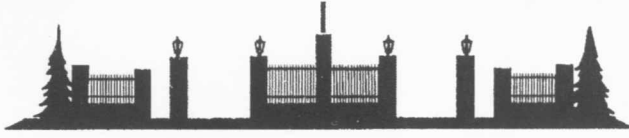

Re: NOTICE OF MOTION – Proposed Telecommunications Tower: 140 Guildwood Parkway

Dear City Council Members (via Councillor Paul Ainslie),

We, the elected members of the Guildwood Village Community Association, representing the Guildwood Village Community (consisting of approximately 3,500 residences and 7,000 constituents), strongly endorse Councillor Ainslie's motion objecting to the proposed site location of 140 Guildwood Parkway, by Bell Mobility to install a cellular telecommunication tower on the site.

The proposed site is not appropriate as there are numerous fears of health threats to its citizens from the effects of the proposed telecommunications tower, a potential devaluation to existing property values within the community and the introduction of an unsightly edifice into a planned community.

We ask that City Council endorse Councillor Ainslie's motion.
