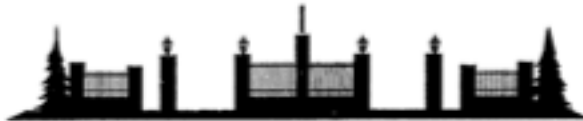

Dear Mr. Greco,

As the Executive of the Guildwood Village Community Association has received numerous objections to the construction of said tower, we are writing this letter to express our deepest displeasure and complete opposition to the proposed telecommunications facility that Bell Mobility Inc. is planning to erect at 140 Guildwood Parkway.

As the ratepayers association for the Guildwood community, we have received a landslide of communication from the community that for the vast majority, express complete opposition to this endeavor. The reasons for this opposition are; fear of health threats to its citizens from the effects of the tower, a devaluation to existing property values, an unsightly edifice in a planned community and others too numerous to list.

In addition the Community is incensed over the fact that there was no public consultation with the community in advance of any agreements being made between Bell Mobility Inc. and the Guildwood Community Presbyterian Church.

We are aware of the Public Consultation Meeting that now has been planned for December 4, 2007 at the Guildwood Community Presbyterian Church, however that meeting was coordinated by Councillor Paul Ainslie at the behest of the Guildwood Village Community Association on behalf of the Community. The following question needs to be asked... "Why was this Public Consultation not initiated by Bell Mobility Inc. and the Guildwood Community Presbyterian Church?"

The Guildwood Village Community Association demands that Bell Mobility Inc. and the Guildwood Community Presbyterian Church dissolve the agreement. We also request/demand that Bell Mobility Inc. find another location for this Proposed Telecommunications Facility that is acceptable to the Community.

We look forward to the Public Consultation on December 4, 2007. The Guildwood Village Community Executive will be in attendance at this meeting.
