

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Please be advised that the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA) is preparing to re-commence with the construction of the "Guild Inn Shoreline Regeneration Project" the week of July 13, 2009.

The Guild Inn Shoreline Regeneration Project was approved under the Environmental Assessment Act in 2004 through successful completion of the *Class Environmental Assessment for Remedial Flood and Erosion Control Projects*, with all approvals for construction received in 2006.

The current phase of work involves extending the armourstone revetment below the Guild Inn access road, which was partially completed in the fall of 2006. Due to fiscal constraints, the remaining shoreline protection features to the west will be completed in subsequent years as funding becomes available.

Access to the shoreline will be restricted intermittently beginning the week of July 13, 2009 and Monday to Friday between 7:30 am – 5:00 pm beginning the week of July 20, 2009 for approximately two weeks while materials are being delivered to the site. During this time public access will be permitted after 5:00 pm daily, and on weekends and holidays only.

Once all materials have been received, the access road will be re-opened to allow public access to the shoreline west of the Guild Inn access road while work is underway.

Construction is estimated to be completed near the end of August 2009.
