

## NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Please be advised that the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA) is preparing to commence the stockpiling of rubble material for the re-commencement of the “Guild Inn Shoreline Regeneration Project”, pending available funding and in anticipation of the commencement of the “Meadowcliffe Drive Erosion Control Project”.

The Meadowcliffe Drive Erosion Control Project was approved under the Environmental Assessment Act on April 2, 2010. In addition to the Class EA process, the project was required to complete an environmental screening under the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act* (CEAA). CEAA was triggered in response to the potential environmental impacts that the project will produce pursuant to subsection 35(2) under the federal *Fisheries Act* and section 5(1) of the federal *Navigable Waters Protection Act*. Construction of this project will commence in the summer of 2010, pending the receipt of federal approvals.

The trucks will access the shoreline via the Guild Inn access road and material will be temporarily stockpiled at the western limit of the Guild Inn site, south of Livingston Road. The rubble material will be delivered from Monday to Friday from 7:30 am to 4:30 pm, excluding holidays. The stockpiling is anticipated to begin mid-May with construction anticipated to continue into late fall as conditions permit. TRCA understands the importance of maintaining public access to the shoreline during construction periods. As such TRCA is committed to allowing public access to the service road for recreational purposes on public holidays, weekday evenings (between 5:00 pm and 7:30 am) and weekends (from 4:30 pm on Friday to 7:30 am on Monday). In the interests of public safety access along the main entrance road off of Guildwood Parkway and westerly along the base of the bluffs will be restricted to construction staff and equipment, during hours of work.
